Preliminary results of the ELITE project

This fourth workshop has brought together some of the members of the ELITE Community of Practice (CoP), with members from different countries and organisations (end users) who share the common interest of improving the management of disasters such as forest fires, earthquakes and floods.

The ELITE CoP members have worked on a table-top exercise in which a lessons learned report from the Japanese earthquake in 2011 had to be developed. This report focused on the problems already identified in the previous workshops (coordination, logistics, interoperability, communication, risk assessment and recovery).

The resources available for the development of the lessons learned report consisted of the use of the ELITE living document prototype, an interview with a firefighter who was on-site in the disaster and their own experience. The aim of this table-top exercise was also to test the usefulness of the living document as a tool to get information and share knowledge among the Community of Practice. Thanks to the contributions of the experts, the consortium partners discussed the table-top exercise's execution, experts' participation and obtained results in order to define future steps and improvement points regarding the ELITE living document.





Final Conference in Warsaw

The ELITE International Scientific Conference on best practices and lessons learned from natural disasters will be held on June 25th -26th, 2014 in Warsaw (Poland).

Within the conference there would be a plenary session (with the papers accepted for plenary session) and a poster session (with the papers accepted for the poster session).
